Social & Emotional Learning

Second Step

- K 5 implementation is the goal.
- According to teachers it is:
 - Giving students tool to deal with frustration
 - A common language to help resolve conflict
 - Handle stressful situations that they encounter

Social & Emotional Learning

- Restorative Justice
 - Alternative to a system of punishment.
 - Punishment may correct behaviors in the short term out of fear but do not address the teaching portion of making better discussions.
 - Current suspensions are reduced by 50% from Last Year to Date comparison.
 - Focuses on repairing harm by bringing the harmed and the aggressor together in safe space to discuss and fix the harm that was done.


Teacher Representative Report
