Later this year, Miner will hold regular community engagement events to get feedback from the community on the planning and design of the master site improvement project. Principal Jackson updated the LSAT on outstanding technology needs.

Comprehensive School Plan - Principal Jackson updated the LSAT on the status of the Comprehensive School Plan, for which he is awaiting final approval. He will provide a further update at the October meeting.

Vision/forum - The LSAT discussed the possibility of adopting a special curriculum for future school years.
