

Community Engagement Committee

- Representatives from multiple Ward 6 schools met at Miner on November 19. Best practices for PTO meetings were shared and this has prompted Miner's PTO leadership to reassess the purpose of our monthly General Meetings, in order to make them more interesting and useful to parents and teachers alike.
- One possible idea: have the General Meetings be more like a "community meeting" where we
 discuss topics relating to the school itself. Possible benefits:
 - PTO would "host," but content would come from multiple sources outside of the PTO
 - Administration could share what's going on in the school: current programs, initiatives, progress, data, and so on
 - Provide opportunity for additional outside speakers to learn about what's going on in the greater community
 - School committees and teams could report on activities: LSAT, PreK Parent, Wellness,
 Garden, Equity, etc.
 - Open forum for parents and teachers to have more time to discuss and share, rather than listen to committee reports
 - The PTO would still hold separate monthly Leadership Team meetings to discuss internal PTO matters (although any decisions needing a vote of the membership would be done at the proposed community meeting)
