LSAT Meeting: November 16, 2021 - 5:00 pm **Meeting Minutes**

The meeting came to order at 5:04pm. The meeting was conducted via Zoom.

Internal LSAT Operations:

- David Treat is leaving Miner so we will need to elect a new Parent Rep and Parent Co-Chair
- PTO President (Parent Organization Rep Julie Muir) can appoint someone until a special election is held
- Special election will be held for both LSAT Parent Rep and PTO Secretary
- Allison Mitchell elected LSAT Co-Chair by consensus (effective upon David Treat's departure)
- Chairs to prepare agenda and request data well in advance of meetings so both admin and LSAT have time to prepare and make requests

School Leadership/Communications/Operations:

- Principal Angry update: she is scheduled to return December 15; AP Bellamy is at Miner through December 10.
- Administration will be holding chats and office hours. Office hours will be Thursday mornings from 9:30-10:30am; the first "chat" will be November 30 and will focus on attendance.
- Communication concerns were addressed at townhall; parents are hopeful that the Communications Plan will be followed
- Staff is still concerned about lack of communications
 - o Staff meeting cancelled (can't be rescheduled due to holiday)
 - o Staff morale is low because of lack of communication and lack of support
 - Hard for staff to support SEL for students when they don't receive SEL support for themselves
- Staff Shortage: personnel committee is still conducting interviews though on-boarding is taking a very long time
- Central Office staff is getting cleared to serve as subs in classrooms

Enrollment:

- Projections: 395 (this year's projection was 376)
- Public budget session to dig into the new budget model is tomorrow (Nov. 17)

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Comprehensive School Plan (CSP):

- CSP is a living document AP Lee started working on it before he left
- Principal Angry has a 3 pronged focus:
 - Teachers improving their practice
 - Kids being and feeling loved
 - Sense of community
- A draft was shared with LSAT Chairs and will be shared with WTU Rep; LSAT Chairs will share with LSAT

"Technology:

- When are we getting devices from DCPS?
 - Lost devices have been documented
 - 4th graders (last year's 3rd graders) received devices 1:1 last year but many were lost; once lost devices are locked by Central Office outstanding devices will be replenished (date unknown) IS Stover will follow up we should have them
 - o 3:1 ratio for K-2nd grade (Ms. Offor is tech POC at Miner; she is tracking what is currently missing)
- Tech Committee is not yet formed (staff has been surveyed about committee interests but none are formed yet)
- PTO has purchased 49 Chromebooks over the last few years
 - o 24 have been given out to SPED, K, and 1st
 - Many were given out as take-home devices last year and either were not returned or were returned broken/unusable
 - O During tonight's meeting the PTO purchased 12 Chromebooks at the request of staff

COVID:

- Miner is meeting the 20% testing threshold
- Families are required to opt OUT, not to opt IN. AP Bellamy to re-send opt-out form to families
- Should PTO write a letter in support of mandatory vaccinations for all students? This has been asked by W6PSPO recommendation is to poll families (table discussion until upcoming PTO Leadership Team and General Meetings)

Budget:

- Upcoming meeting for LSAT to learn about new budget process
- Be thinking of priorities in advance of December meeting (LSAT Chairs to share past priority lists)
