



UPDATED ISOLATION GUIDANCE FOR DCPS STUDENTS AND STAFF

The isolation period for students and staff will follow CDC and DC Health guidance and may vary based on the severity of the COVID-19 infection and whether a positive individual participates in additional testing. The diagram below explains when an individual can exit isolation.
















If your child has no symptoms, or mild to moderate symptoms: They may stop isolating after day 7 if they take a COVID-19 test on or after day 5 and receive a negative test result AND they have been fever-free for at least 24 hours without the aid of medication.

The child may return to school on day 8 after reporting a negative test, and they must wear a well-fitted mask in the community until 10 days after testing positive. If they test positive after day 5 or no test is administered, they can return to school at least 10 days from when symptoms first started or initial positive test result was received.









They must isolate at least 10 days from when symptoms first started.









Additional testing may be required. Please follow the advice of your health care provider.

DCPS Reopen Strong - New Mask Policy


Students, staff, and visitors will no longer be required to wear a mask when outdoors at our schools, effective immediately.


