












Enrollment Discussion

- Enrollment is open! Visit the <u>DCPS Enrollment page</u> today.
- If you were matched via My School DC Lottery, you must enroll by May 1 or you could lose your seat.
- If you are interested in DCPS aftercare, you must be enrolled for 2 business days before aftercare enrollment opens (date TBD but usually early June).
- ALL students must enroll for next year. They must complete the <u>enrollment packet</u> as well as provide proof of residency (<u>click here</u> for a list of supporting documents).
- New students must also provide proof of age (birth certificate, hospital records, previous school records, baptismal certificate, passport).
- Enrollment forms (including supporting documents) can all be submitted online or in person in the Miner Main Office.

Local School Advisory Team


- LSAT is present in every DCPS school and is comprised of elected representatives of parents, teachers, staff, and a community member plus PTO leader and WTU building rep.

Note: Currently owe an add'l \$5,000 for Food Corp. & New Checking Account has been established for Community Table (~\$240 Balance after March Purchases)

Principal's Fund received over \$11K in March, will be removed from PTO's account in subsequent months.



Month End Balance


