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Mission/Vision:

- When Mr. Dance came to Miner we had no mission/vision so this year we will start the process
- Will involve ALL stakeholders, beginning with staff, then caregivers, and finally community members
- We want to focus on the fundamental traits that make Miner what it is, including cultural objectives

Comprehensive School Plan (CSP):

- Definition: an overall plan in which we set goals for our school culture, in addition to establishing steps needed to achieve those goals
- The Miner CSP is currently in the process of being reviewed by the team lead by IS Carruthers
- Focus areas: shared learning, engagement, culture of achievement, academics
- Goals set for each focus area, then progress monitoring is conducted, and an action plan is shared. A priority of equity is included in each plan/goal.
- Highlights:
 - Shared learning: goal of ensuring what is happening in general education classrooms is happening in special education classrooms
 - Engagement: goal to ensure 80% favorable opinion of Miner and 100% family engagement in some form.
 - Oculture of achievement: goal to increase students feeling loved, challenged, and prepared up to 60% from 38% last year (Miner is putting a big emphasis on this based on how low the score was last year); also want to increase in seat attendance from 85% to 94%
 - o Academics: growth goals for BOY, MOY, EOY, PARCC, etc. Action plan includes teachers attending reading clinics and other plans to ensure all students are successful.
- Next meeting Mr. Dance will bring district goals to compare to school goals.
- Mr. Dance will share the CSP with the LSAT after the cluster support team makes edits (before the October meeting).

New Staff Support:

- Focus on ensuring there are effective supports all around
- Shoutout to staff who have already gone out of their way to help new staff

Enrollment Update:

- Currently we are 110% enrolled, leading cluster 4
- Last year we started at 367 students and ended at 386
- We currently have 406 students enrolled

Communications:

- Remind and Aspen/Blackboard will be the primary tools for communication sign up for Remind with your teacher and reach out to them or Mr. Copeland with questions or troubleshooting.
- Some teachers will use Class Dojo as well
- Goal is to ensure all families are aware of everything going on so all our families (not just our white families) attend and feel included
