 - o Phonics:
 - K and 1: DIBBLS Data well below 29% K and more in 1
 - 2 & 3: Half of our kids are well below on Basic Phonics
 - They're focusing on basic phonics
 - iReady: Computer assessed
 - significant portions of children in the upper grades are well below grade level
 - Adopted UFLI (university of Florida) as gold standard phonics curriculum
 - Big focus on books in hand.
 - o Math:
 - Decreased # of students who were 2 or more grades below level
 - Improvement in math goals
 - DC CAPE Testing: Grade 3-5 Standardized Testing
 - Testing is coming. It doesn't rule the school.
