Dear Miner Elementary Community,

With the release of Mayor Bowser's Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) budget for Fiscal Year 2022 to Fiscal Year 2027, DC Public Schools (DCPS) is reaching out to ensure you and your community understand the implications for your school's modernization project.

The timeline and funding for the Old Miner ECE School project has *not changed*. As part of a comprehensive city-wide effort, your project will also include the expansion of early childhood offerings to serve a limited number of infants and toddlers. The project will begin planning and design in Fiscal Year 2023, with anticipated project completion for School Year 2024-25. *Please note, the DC Council will review and potentially make revisions in the coming months.*

For this project, DCPS and the DC Department of General Services (DGS) anticipate completing the project in two years, with one year for design, planning and initial construction and one year for full construction. This project will expand the early childhood education offerings for the site.

Throughout the modernization, DCPS will continue to share information with the community and offer opportunities to provide feedback. We appreciate your continued engagement in this process. We look forward to partnering with you in the coming years to support DC students with a world-class education in modernized facilities.
